**Applies to:** ProGold i2 3.xx

**Purpose:** Provide instructions for manually installing SQL Express 2005. This action is typically required when a client is using Microsoft SQL Server 2000 Desktop Engine (**MSDE 2000**) and needs to upgrade to SQL Express 2005.

**Procedure:** Actions required to install SQL Express 2005:

- **Step 1: Go to progoldinstall folder:**
  - Open **My Computer** icon
  - Select the drive (pick drive letter where Pro Gold i2 was installed)
  - Select the **Pro Gold i2** folder
  - Select **ProGoldInstall** folder
  
- **Step 2: Begin the installation:**
  - Select the **setup.exe** file
  - Accept the license agreement
  - Click the **Next** button (Installs the SQL 2005 Setup Support files)
  - Click the **Next** button (Initiates the Microsoft SQL Server Installation Wizard)
  - Click the **Next** button (Initiates the installation)
  - Click the **Next** button (Confirms the System Configuration Check and starts the installation)
  - Enter Registration information (Your name and company information)
    - **Note:** Uncheck **Hide Advanced Configuration** options; click the **Next** button
  
- **Step 3: Install Features:**
  - Install all features at the **Feature Selection** screen
  - Verify/choose disk drive
  - Click the **Next** button to continue
  - Accept the default named instance: **SQLExpress**
  - Click the **Next** button to continue
  - At **Service Account** screen, click the **Next** button (Accept the default settings)
  
- **Step 3: Set Authentication Mode:**
  - At **Authentication Mode** screen,
    - Select the **Mixed Mode** option
    - Enter → ProGold2002E in password and confirm password fields (password is case sensitive)
    - Click the **Next** button
  - At **Collation** screen, click the **Next** button (Accept default settings)

**Subject:** Manually Install SQL Express 2005

- **Step 4: Set Configuration Options:**
  - At **Configuration Options** screen,
    - Verify **Enable User Instances** box is checked (if not, check it)
    - Check the **Add User to the SQL Server Administrator Role** box, click the **Next** button
  - At **Error and Usage Reporting** screen, click the **Next** button to continue
  - At **Ready to Install** screen, click the **Install** button to begin the installation
  - At **Setup Programs** screen, click the **Next** button to continue
  
- **Step 5: Activate Remote Client Connections:**
  - At **Completing Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Setup** screen, select the **Surface Configuration Tool** option
    - At **SQL Server 2005 Surface Area Configuration** screen
    - Select the **SQLEXPRESS** component option
    - Select the **Service** option
    - Click the **Stop** button to temporarily stop the service
    - Select the **Remote Connections** option
    - Select the **Local and Remote Connections** option
    - Select **Using both TCP/IP and named pipe** options
    - Select the **Service** option
    - Click the **Start** button to restart the service
    - Click the **OK** button to close the **SQL Server 2005 Surface Area Configuration** screen
    - Click the **Finish** button the **Completing Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Setup** screen to complete the installation
